

# Special Session Ethical and Legal Matters on Mobile Device Intellectual Capital & Archiving

## Overview

Mobile learning is gaining more and more penetration not only in education, but also in traditionally more normatively legitimate fields, as is medicine, libraries and documentation centers, national and supranational venture archives...

Mobile devices increasingly penetrate inner core instruments and competencies in an ever growing frenzy for direct manipulation and immersion. - Medical data, community policies and applicable tools
- Patient centered e-health data collection and archiving
- Technologies, semantics, and ethical issues for the invasion potential

This special session is intended to attract research papers showing novel applications in the field of mobile device interfaces and mobile computing instruction & learning. We cordially invite researchers, developers and all those working in this field to submit work under the topic mentioned above.

NB: Papers may address one or more of the above listed sub-topics, although authors should not feel limited by them. Unlisted but related sub-topics are also acceptable.

## Contribution Types

Proposals for participation in the Special Session can be submitted in the following formats:

- Full Papers – These include mainly accomplished research results and have 5 pages or more.
- Short Papers – These are mostly composed of work in progress reports or fresh developments and have 3 pages or more.
